Summer Program 2010

The 10-week summer program begins June 14 and runs through Aug. 20 at Hugh Gallagher Elementary School. The program runs from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.

The Off-the-Hill clinics feature experts and local volunteers who offer outdoor

adventures, arts, and cultural experiences to the youth. These have included golf, kayaking, water-skiing, theater, drumming, Latino language, food, and dance. Over 30 youth participate in the summer clinics and typically report having many satisfying learning experiences and challenges. The Off-the-Hill clinics are offered to Elementary, Middle, and High School students.


